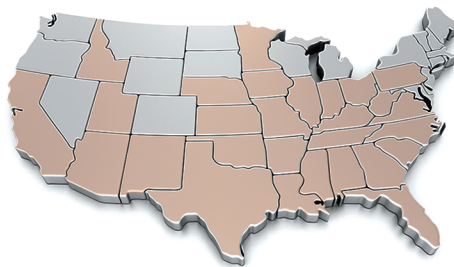
Quail Forever is dedicated to the conservation of quail, pheasants and other wildlife through habitat improvements, public awareness, education and land management policies and programs

## ADVOCACY

Farm Bill provides key funding for private lands conservation

### Conservation Reserve Program

Improve water quality, prevent soil erosion, and reduce loss of wildlife habitat

### CP-33: "Bobwhite Buffers"

In over 14 states, breeding bobwhite densities were 70-75% greater around CP-33 buffered fields than unbuffered crop fields

### CP-38: State Acres for Wildlife Enhancement

17 quail-specific practices in addition to upland habitat priorities
