#### Conservation Reserve Program

Improve water quality, prevent soil erosion, and reduce loss of wildlife habitat

#### CP-33: "Bobwhite Buffers"

In over 14 states, breeding bobwhite densities were 70-75% greater around CP-33 buffered fields than unbuffered crop fields

#### CP-38: State Acres for Wildlife Enhancement
